**Pupil Safety** in an effort to keep our children safe, we respectfully ask that parents do not drive into the school carpark or block the entrance and exit at any time of the day. Also whilst waiting for your children could you please be considerate to other parents/children by not playing ball games or allowing children to race about the area.

We would like to remind parents and carers that it is their responsibility to update the school **DAILY** on their child or children's **absence** from school. We would like to make you aware that from 1 September 2017, the criteria for the issue of a FPN is:

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.
