Unfortunately, if contact has not been made, or an insufficient reason has been provided e.g. feeling unwell or athlete's foot, it will be marked as unauthorised. Where the school is concerned about any period of absence, medical evidence will be required and failure to provide this may result in a fixed penalty notice.

From 1 September 2017, the criteria for the issue of a FPN is:

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.
