

REMINDER ON SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

The school requires parents/carers to call the school on the morning of **each day** that their child is absent. Please note a valid reason is required in order to authorise absences *i.e. poorly or ill is insufficient*. **More detail** such as **been sick, or has a temperature**, is required.

Unfortunately, if contact has not been made, or an insufficient reason has been provided e.g. **feeling unwell or athlete's foot**, it will be marked as **unauthorised**. Where the school is concerned about any period of absence, **medical evidence will be required** and failure to provide this may result in a **fixed penalty notice**. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please see the attached helpful guidance overleaf, which can also be found on our website.

From 1 September 2017, the criteria for the issue of a FPN (Fixed Penalty Notice) is:

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.
