### IMPORTANT ABSENCE INFORMATION

As you are already aware, we do not authorise any holiday taken during term time and as a Local Authority school, we are required to follow Norfolk County guidelines on all attendance matters.

Please note the following criteria for the issue of a FPN (Fixed Penalty Notice):

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.

We would like to make you aware that should you receive a fine, which is currently £60 per child per parent please do not ignore this, as failure to do so may result in court proceedings and considerable costs.
