

REMINDER ON SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

The school requires parents/carers to call the school on the morning of **each day** that their child is absent. Please note a valid reason is required in order to authorise absences *i.e. poorly or ill is insufficient*. **More detail** such as **been sick, or has a temperature**, is required.

Unfortunately, if contact has not been made, or an insufficient reason has been provided e.g. feeling unwell or athlete's foot, it will be marked as unauthorised. Where the school is concerned about any period of absence, medical evidence will be required and failure to provide this may result in a fixed penalty notice. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please see our helpful leaflet, which can also be found on our website.

From 1 September 2017, the criteria for the issue of a FPN (Fixed Penalty Notice) is:

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.
