BE PREPARED FOR DEALING WITH CORONAVIRUS

We are making sure that **we keep updated with latest government advice on Coronavirus**. We need to ensure that we are prepared if the government announces that schools have to close. We are taking steps already so that we can still support our children's learning. The staff are preparing. It may help parents to think ahead too!

Latest Government and NHS Guidance

If your child has a high temperature (**38 degrees or more**) or a cough, your child must **remain at home for 7 consecutive days**. Schools must send any child home exhibiting these symptoms.
