Dear Parent/Carer,

My name is Victoria Scott and I am a specialist teacher who works with your child's school as part of their educational psychology team.

I am currently studying for an MSc Conversion in Psychology, and I am starting my dissertation project. The aim of my project is to look at literacy in children who were born preterm/prematurely. I am contacting you as I am looking for participants for my study. The participants I am looking for are primary aged children who attend a mainstream school setting and were born before 37 weeks. I am also looking for children who were born between 38 – 42 weeks as a comparison group.

The participants will be asked to do some tests that will take up to 45 minutes. None of these tests involve reading and writing and children usually find them fun and at least interesting. I will also ask you to complete a questionnaire and your child's teacher/senco.

The study will hopefully provide valuable insight into preterm children's learning which can then enable more personalised support as needed.

If you think that you and your child would like to participate, please can you let your school SENCo or class teacher know and they will provide you with a participant invitation letter for you and your child.
