Adhan: The Muslim call to ritual prayer made by a muezzin from the minaret of a mosque .

Islam: The religion of Muslims.

Muslim: People who follow the faith of Islam

Submit: To accept the full authority of God.

Allah: One of the many names for God.

Apostle: A strong believer/teacher of the faith.

Ramadan: The ninth month of the Muslim year, during which strict fasting is observed from dawn to sunset.

Mecca: The Holiest city in Islam.

Muhammad: The prophet of Allah who told his message

Why do people have different views about the idea of God?

Peace is a central concept in Islam. "Islam" means "peace" - it is usually described as the peace gained through willing submission to Allah. A Muslim is "one who submits to Allah" in this way. Willing submission brings peace.

A few thoughts from Muslims about what they think God is like:

'He thinks of others before himself and is a careful person'

'I believe he is watching me all the time and helping me'
