Pilgrimage: It is a symbol in action of someone going on a journey for their faith.
Community: A group of people who have something
Commitment: Putting all your effort into a decision or action.
Faith: A strong belief and trust in a religious teaching.
Pilgrim: A person who goes on a pilgrimage.
Hajj: The name of the 'greater' pilgrimage in Islam.
Umrah: The name of another pilgrimage in Islam.
Kumbh Mela: The name of the pilgrimage in Hinduism.
Shrine: A holy place because of a sacred person or item marked by a building.

Why Pilgrimage?
 Pilgrimage is an essential part of life and living. Christians see life itself in terms of a journey, coming from God and returning to God. This is true of other world religions where pilgrimage is also important.

A pilgrimage is a symbol in action. It represents the journey of the Christian life from earth to heaven. The Church is sometimes described as a pilgrim people.
