Covenant: An agreement
Ark: A boat that give protection or safety.
Old Testament: The first part of the Christian bible made up of 39 books. (Before Jesus)
Hebrew: The language spoken and the group of people living in what is now Israel and Palestine.
Dove: A white bird symbolising peace.
Genesis: Beginnings. The first book of the old testament.
New Testament: The second part of the Christian bible made up of the gospels and other books.
Vow: A sacred promise that cannot be broken.
Obey: To carry out a command or instruction.

- Watch or read several different versions of the story of Noah's Ark.
