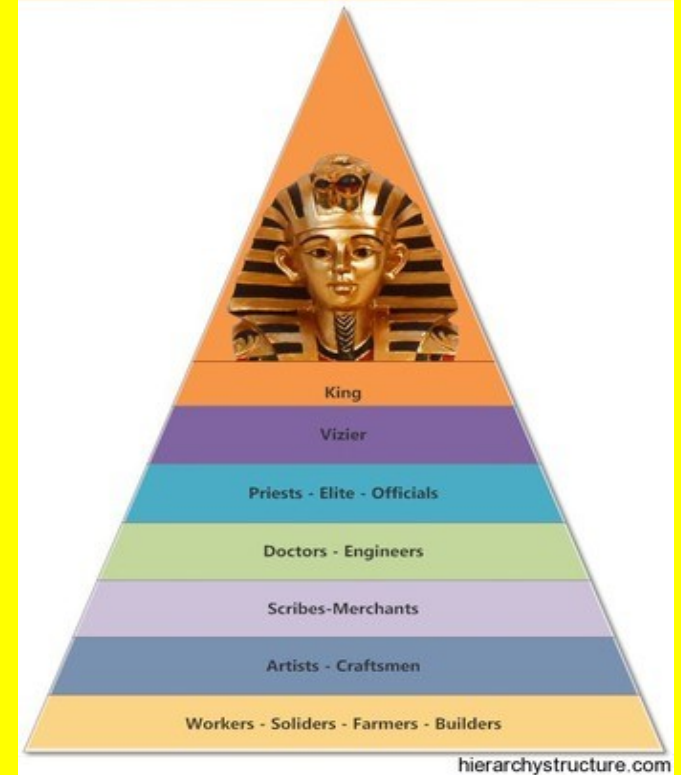


KEY FACTS

- The civilization of Ancient Egypt was located along the Nile River in northeast Africa. The Nile was the source of much of the Ancient Egypt's wealth.
- Egyptian men and women wore makeup. It was thought to have healing powers, plus it helped protect their skin from the sun.
- Historians usually group the history of Ancient Egypt into three major kingdoms called the Old Kingdom, the Middle Kingdom, and the New Kingdom.
- When a loved one had passed away, they believed in preserving the body which was called mummification. The Egyptians believed that this would make their soul live on forever.
