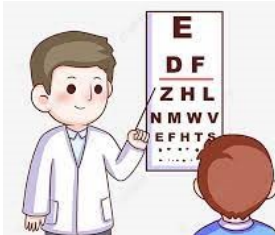

FREE EYE AND HEARING TESTS

It's common that many children can often have undetected eyesight and hearing problems because children find ways to cope or are just unaware that they don't see or hear as well as they could. **Eyesight or hearing problems can impact your child's performance both in and out of the classroom** and we have witnessed amazing differences in a children's performance and confidence when problems have been detected.



We understand that Covid may have meant that checks could not be made for your child's hearing and eyesight.

There are opticians locally (Specsavers Sainsbury's and Centenary Opticians Bowthorpe) or in Norwich that will offer free eye test and hearing tests after school, weekends and in school holidays.
