



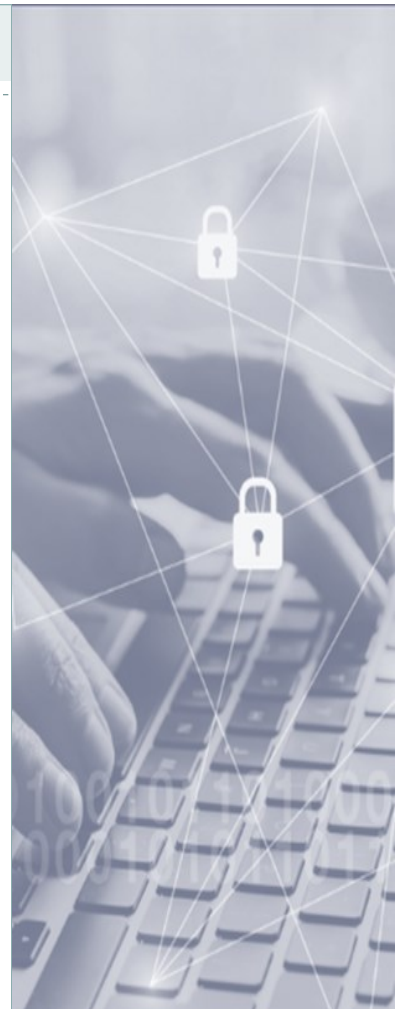
THIS HALF TERM, WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT:
